





# Simplify Life with Note-taking Apps

Do you often feel overwhelmed by the amount of information and tasks you have to deal with every day? Do you struggle to remember important details, deadlines, or ideas? I sure do. If you were to ask me what my vehicle's tire size is, I might be able to recall it, but probably not. There are other things I'd like to be able to remember, like what streaming subscriptions I have and when they are due for renewal, but unless they're written down, there's no way.

Like me, you might benefit from using note-taking apps like OneNote, Evernote, Google Keep, and Joplin. These apps allow you to capture, organize, and access your notes from any device, anytime, anywhere, because the content is stored - in the cloud. They help get thoughts, memories, and facts out of your unreliable brain and into the app, where they are safe, accessible, and best yet, searchable. If I get an idea, the only guarantee that it will be remembered a week from now is if I get it into written form.

Capture everything. Whether it's a grocery list, a meeting agenda, a book recommendation, or a random thought, you can quickly jot it down in your note-taking app. You can also use voice or image notes to capture information without typing. This way, you don't have to worry about forgetting or losing anything. There are a lot of options you can choose from. If you prefer tactile writing, you can use a little mini journal notebook. I previously mentioned this in my article 'The Leather Notebook of Ideas'. Most people are likely to want something digital. My preference is Google Keep, in part because I already leverage a lot of other Google apps. Not only do I use Google Keep to store thoughts and ideas, I use it as expanded memory. I'm always forgetting important tax tips for when I need them in February, or when things are expiring. I make separate notes in Keep for major purchases, where the best places are to eat certain foods, or get certain grocery items, a wish list, and so much more. Since the app is both on my phone and bookmarked in my web browser, with the data stored in the cloud, it's simple to add things or just look something up.

Using note-taking apps can help you simplify your life and get more done. By getting information out of your head and into the cloud, you can free up some mental space and focus on what matters most.






#### **Trees**



Did you know that Montgomery's tree coverage is far less compared to Bowness and Parkdale (twelve per cent versus twenty percent)?

Trees add shade, windbreaks, reduced heating and cooling costs, habitats for birds, clean air, and beauty to our neighbourhood. Let's close the gap. The City of Calgary's Urban Forestry Planting Program supports homeowners to plant trees on the city-owned portion of the property (back-of-walk or boulevard) - for free! Homeowners work with city staff to choose a location and pick a tree (or multiple trees) from their approved list. The City safely digs the hole, plants the tree, and waters the tree for a few years until it is well established. To access this opportunity, submit a request to the Urban Forestry Planting Department through 311. Requests now may result in a tree on your property in the spring or summer of 2024.
